Projects Requiring a Building Permit

Building Permits in the Village of Granton are required for projects exceeding a value of \$1000. The projects most likely to require a permit are new structures or those that change the structure or use of a building. For example, you will likely need a building permit to:

- Build a garage or permanent shed
- Installing a new driveway
- Changing the use of a room (converting a garage to a living room)
- Re-reroof your house
- Install new windows
- Adding a deck
- Erecting a fence

Not all construction requires a building permit. Projects that don't usually need a permit include:

- repainting your house
- adding kitchen cabinets
- replacing certain kitchen appliances
- repaving your driveway
- installing floor coverings, or
- erecting a small decorative fence
- installing a garden trellis

Costs: Building permits are five dollars plus a dollar for every \$1000 in value.

• Example: A building permit for a 10,000 roof would be \$15.00

To Apply for a building permit:

- Download and fill out the building permit application
- Send application with fees to: Village of Granton, Box 69, Granton WI 54436
- Building permits are approved at the board meeting and sent out after approval
- Post your building permit in your window
- Permits are valid for 1 year
