If an operation involves the sale of food, an inspection of the premises will be conducted by the persons from the Wisconsin Department of Health and Social Service (DHSS), or county officials issuing the restaurant license.

For operations that do not sell food, the licensing municipality is responsible for ensuring that the applicant's premises are in compliance with sanitation requirements. The requirements are set forth in ch.HSS 196, Wisconsin Administration Code. Assistance or information about the guidelines may be obtained from DHSS.

No person shall in any manner, or upon any pretense, or by any device, directly or indirectly sell, expose for sale, possess with intent to sell, exchange, barter, dispose of or give away any cigarettes or tobacco products to any person not holding a license as herein provided or a permit under ss. 139.30 to 139.41 or 139.79 without first obtaining a license from the clerk of the city, village or town wherein such privilege is sought to be exercised.

A city, village, or town clerk may not issue a license under sub. (1) unless the applicant specifies in the license application whether the applicant will sell, exchange, barter, dispose of, or give away the cigarette or tobacco products over the counter or in a vending machine, or both.

Except as provided in par. (b), upon filing of a proper written application a license shall be issued on July 1 of each year or when applied for and continue in force until the following June 30 unless sooner revoked. The city, village or town may charge a fee for the license of not less than \$5 nor more than \$100 per year which shall be paid to the city, village or town treasurer before the license is issued.
